ORDINANCE NO. 1805**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CORAOPOLIS, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1777, ENACTED MARCH 12, 2014, TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE PLANTING, MAINTENANCE, PRESERVATION AND REMOVAL OF SHADE TREES, SHRUBS AND OTHER VEGETATION WITHIN THE LEGAL BOUNDARIES OF THE BOROUGH AND TO ESTABLISH THE RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITY OF THE COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Coraopolis Borough Council has heretofore on March 12, 2014, enacted into law Ordinance No. 1777 known as the Shade Tree Ordinance; and,


WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Coraopolis desires to amend Ordinance 1777 by adding the following:

J. Any "Shade Tree" or tree on public or private property that is deemed a public safety hazard because of rotting limbs, trunks or roots shall be removed within 30 days of notice from the Borough of Coraopolis or the Shade Tree Commission. Said tree removal shall be the responsibility of the property owner. Failure to comply with notice to remove said tree will cause the Borough of Coraopolis or the Shade Tree Commission to have said tree removed with the property owner liable for all cost; which if not paid will be liened on said property.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** as follows:

ORDAINED and **ENACTED** by the Council of Coraopolis Borough, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, this 12th day of September, 2018.


