**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF
CORAOPOLIS, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
AMENDING THE LAWS OF THE BOROUGH OF
CORAOPOLIS TO UPDATE “STOP SIGN”
LOCATIONS IN THE BOROUGH.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Coraopolis has the authority to enact and amend ordinances that it deems necessary for the health and safety of the residents and inhabitant of the Borough; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Coraopolis has determined that the placement of “Stop Signs” at the intersection set forth below would enhance the health and safety of occupants of motor vehicles and pedestrians.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Coraopolis as follows:

SECTION I: That Stop signs shall be erected at the following intersections:

- a. Stop signs at the intersection of Vine Street and Ridge Avenue for both northbound and southbound traffic.
- b. Stop signs at the intersection of Vine Street and Vance Avenue for both northbound and southbound traffic.
- c. Stop sign at the intersection of Vine Street and Edgewood Avenue for southbound traffic.
- d. Stop sign at the intersection of Vine Street and Devonshire Avenue for northbound traffic.


SECTION II: That proper signage be erected at the aforesaid intersection.

SECTION III: That the within Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage thereof.
